The secure way to screen your content globally

The Artinii Cinema Player (ACP) is the tool that brings it all together within the Artinii.Pro ecosystem and makes all screenings come to life. The proprietary ACP player is completely free and very easy to use. It is not only a key element in ensuring the safety of all AV content, it makes the screening process easier in all its mutations. One of the highlights being that screenings can easily take place in locations without Internet coverage.

To ensure optimal performance, please choose the player that matches your operating system.



### Windows

- OS: Windows 10 version 1903 or newer
- CPU: at least Intel Core i5 (recommended Intel Core i7)
- RAM: at least 4GB (recommended 8GB and up)

- OS: macOS 15 Sequoia or newer
- CPU: Apple Silicon M1 or higher
- RAM: at least 4GB (recommended 8GB and up)

## STEP 2

Allow the Artinii Cinema Player app to manage and play your media files. Follow the on-screen instructions.



### We need some permissions

File system access lets Artinii Cinema Player manage and play your media files for the best experience.

- 1) Click 'Open settings' to open the Windows Privacy & security → File system page.
- 2) Turn on 'File system access' and 'Let apps access your file system'.
- 3) Turn on the toggle for Artinii Cinema Player in the list of apps.

*Windows will close Artinii Cinema Player after you change these settings. Launch it again to continue.*

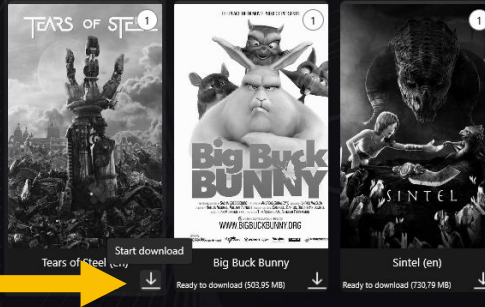
Here you can see your film library. All films you have **purchased or sent** by the distributor will be displayed here.

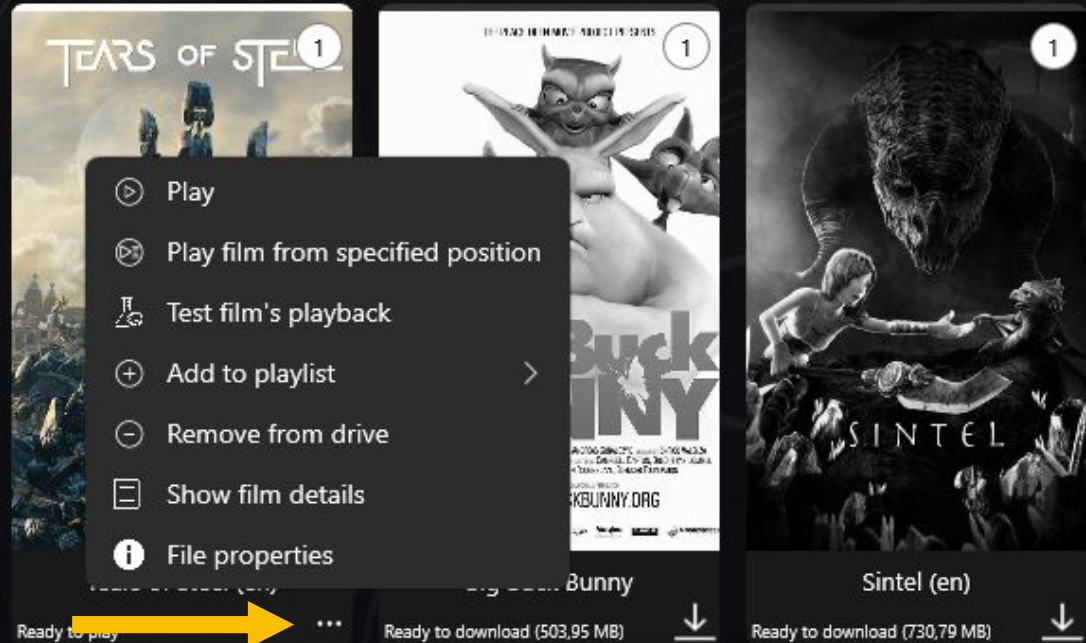

## STEP 5

Click on the three dots on a film card for quick actions for managing the film:

- **Play** – Starts the film immediately.
- **Play from specified position** – Begins playback from a user-defined timestamp.
- **Test film's playback** – Perform a technical test to ensure the film plays correctly.
- **Add to playlist** – Adds the selected film to a playlist for grouped playback.
- **Remove from disk** – Deletes the film file from your local storage (can be re-downloaded later).
- **Show film details** – Opens a detailed page with all metadata about the film.
- **File properties** – Displays technical file information such as size, format, or resolution.




## NAVIGATION PANEL


This is the primary navigation panel for the app:

- **Add local media** – Import and manage your own DRM-free local video files.
- **Create media group** – Organize multiple films into curated thematic or event-based collections.
- **Downloads** – Manage and monitor your active downloads.
- **Playlists** – View, create, and edit custom playlists of films.
- **Settings** – Configure application preferences, account details, and playback behavior.
- **Prepare screening** – Set up and launch a cinema-like screening session.
- **Test order/delivery** – Download a test film file to verify that your setup works correctly with DRM-protected content.
- **Media security status** – Information about the status of your media security, such as DRM, security level, and HDCP.
- **Feedback & help** – Contact support or share feedback about the app.

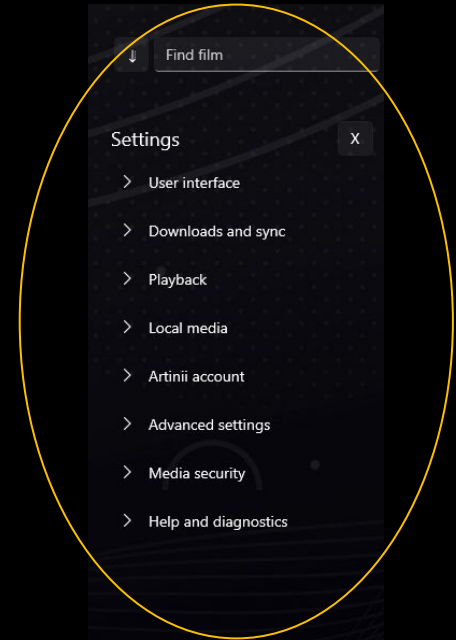
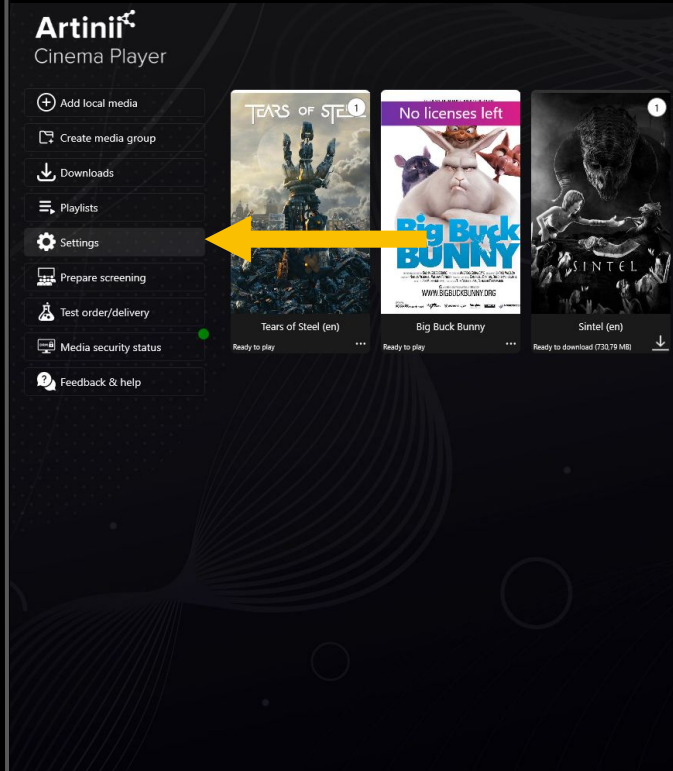

# SETTINGS

Click on **Settings** to view and set the player features. This section houses all configurable app options:

- **User interface** – Change language, library layout, sorting.
- **Downloads and sync** – Manage synchronization intervals, storage locations.
- **Playback** – Configure keyboard shortcuts, subtitles, background of playback window.
- **Local media** – Configure engine used to play your media files and their look in the library.
- **Artinii account** – Manage your user profile and logout.
- **Advanced settings** – Enable advanced projection and perform other advanced tasks.
- **Media security** - Enables DRM functionality, license refresh, and media security status
- **Help and diagnostics** – Tools for troubleshooting, running diagnostics.

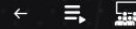
## SIDEBAR

This sidebar gives you full control over a selected film:

- **Play film** – Immediately starts playback.
- **Test film's playback** – Perform a technical test to ensure the film plays correctly.
- **Add to playlist** – Adds the current film to a selected playlist.
- **Remove film from disk** – Deletes the local copy of the film but keeps the license intact.
- **Configure subtitles** – Select or add subtitle tracks, if available. You can also set the display of subtitles for the film here.
- **Adjust film display size** – Scale film to fit your projection needs.
- **File properties** – Shows technical details of the film file.
- **Refresh license** – Manually renew the DRM license if playback issues occur.

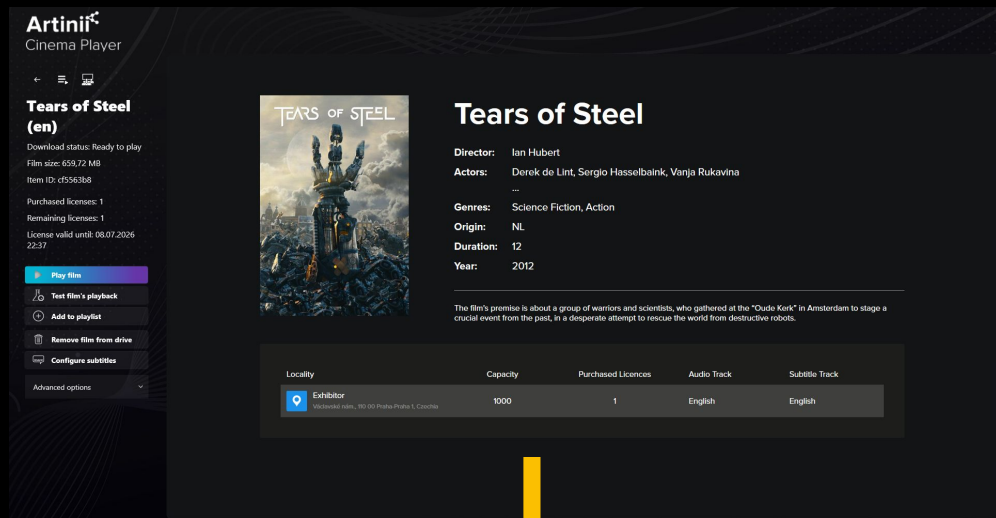
## SCREENING

- 1) Leave the library window on your computer desktop. This is the environment where you can control the playback of the film.
- 2) The second window (which appears when you start the film or playlist) is for the audience. Drag it with your mouse to right side of the screen, where the window will then be displayed. Use the **Expand Screen** function for a quality film experience.

### How to expand the screen?

Use this way: Start -> Settings -> System -> Display -> Multiple displays in the drop down list, select expand desktop.

## PREPARE SCREENING

Also you can use the **Prepare screening** function, where you simply select the device on which you want to project. The film window will then be displayed here.

## EMERGENCY LICENSE

If problems occur during playback (e.g. power failure) and there are no licenses left for playback, an emergency license can be requested to complete the screening. Simply **click on Request emergency license**, write the reason for the request and it will be **granted immediately**. This function can be used even without an internet connection.
